Equipment

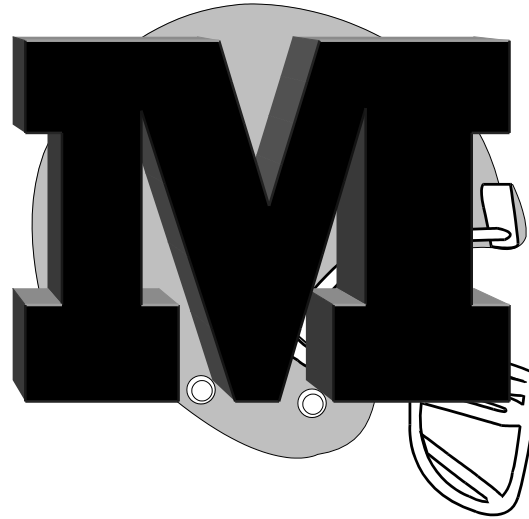

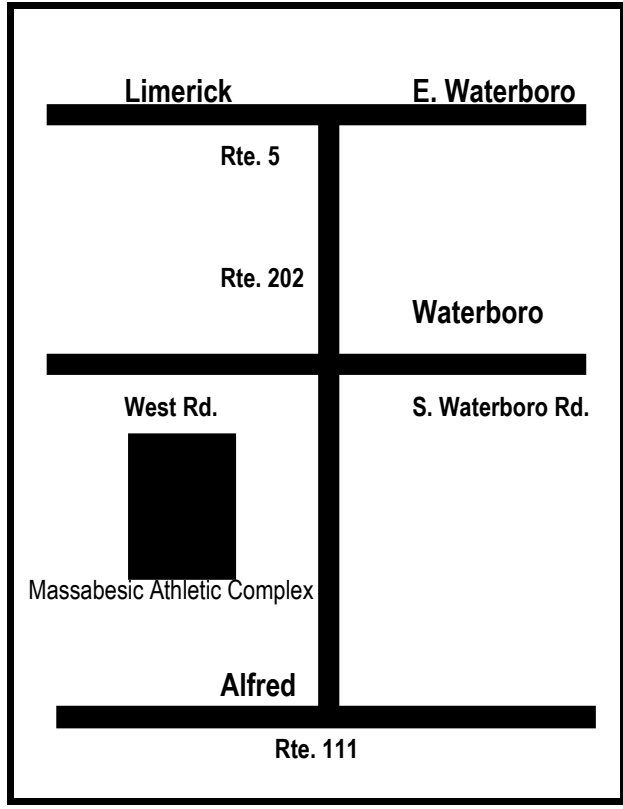
